St. Paul of the Cross is founder of the [Passionists order](#), whose mission is to “keep alive in the world the love of Jesus Crucified as seen in His Sacred Passion.” Born Paolo Francesco Danei on January 3, 1694, in Ovada, Italy, he was one of 16 children, but only six survived infancy.
